1 A/C returned due to mechanical failure (PDF 41). A/C 2487-F Searl is presumed to be that aircraft.

Thus three above did not attack and three others of the 6 above without the ot label did attack. The six are: Hunter-Frazier, Heintzelman, Darner, Ford, Binger, Nelson.

But A/C 2390-X Ford interrogation report revealed that route followed as briefed. Therefore assumed to be over target. In addition, it is also presumed Hunter-Frazier were over target, and also Heintzelman based on number of dots in name on blank interrogation report.

Those presumed not to be over target (for unknown reasons): A/C 2596-N Darner as not verified on interrogation report and A/C 7190-L Binger and A/C 2543-B Nelson as not verified on interrogation report.
